

Pastor's Pondering...

Approximately ten years ago, there were periods in my life where I encountered hardships without a church to serve or stable employment, resulting in several years of financial struggle. In the midst of these trying times, while actively seeking a church to serve, I diligently pursued numerous job opportunities and turned to prayer for guidance, questioning my calling to ministry within a church setting.

However, none of the jobs I pursued proved successful, leading me to believe that indeed God had called me to minister in a church. During this painful period, I clung to my faith in God, trusting that God would not forsake me and that God's plans for me were better than my own.

Recently, while revisiting my old prayer journal from 2015, I recalled the agony I experienced, finding solace at that time in reading Psalms: "O Lord, why do you hide yourself in times of trouble? How long, O God, will You hide Your face? Will you forget me forever? How long must I wrestle with my thoughts and every day have sorrow in my heart? How long will my enemy triumph over me? Show me Your ways, O Lord; teach me Your paths. But I trust in your unfailing love; my heart rejoices in your salvation. I will sing to the Lord for God has been good to me" (Psalms Ch. 10, 11, 13, 25).

Despite the uncertainty of the path in those days, my desire was to live according to God's Word, to worship regularly, meditate on Scripture, and continually seek God's will. And I repented for whatever I remembered. Ultimately, God made the impossible possible, miraculously guiding me onto the right path. God has never abandoned me; God is my source of pride, life, and hope!

March falls in the middle of Lent, a forty-day period leading up to Easter, which begins on Ash Wednesday. During Lent, we prepare for the glorious celebration of Easter on the final day of March. It is a time to deepen and strengthen our faith, engaging in self-examination, fasting, prayer, and repentance, seeking God's forgiveness and grace to avoid repeating past mistakes. With God's help, we can achieve this!

Faith is not easily attained; it requires effort and wrestling with God, experiencing God's power to establish a solid foundation. This Lenten season, let us discern God's desires for us, growing in mature faith through worship, Scripture, deep prayer, and good deeds. May we uncover God's will as we follow Jesus' journey to the cross and experience the God who makes the impossible possible. Blessed be God, day by day! Amen.

Session Meeting Review

The Session met on February 13, 2024 at 3:00 P.M.

<u>Minutes:</u> The minutes of the regular stated session meeting on January 23 and the minutes of the Annual Meeting on February 11th were approved.

<u>Financial:</u> The profit and loss statement for January 2024 was presented by Angelo Guarino. A motion was made to approve the report; motion carried.

Music & Worship: The average attendance for January was 23. The last communion was celebrated on February 2nd; 27 people received communion. The next communion will be served on March 3rd. Stuart showed the new candles for the sanctuary, which burn with candle oil rather than wax. The bell choir plans to ring on Palm Sunday. Our Ash Wednesday service (February 14) will be a 'drop-in' service from 4:30 to 5:30.

Building & Grounds: T.S. Roofing will submit an estimate for replacing the garage roof this spring. Doyle Security will give us a cost to install a video doorbell on the side entrance. Hyde Stone has quoted a price for two Wi-fi thermostats that can be adjusted from a smart phone. Our snow blower's motor (crank shaft) is broken; Burrville Power Equipment will give us a cost for a new blower. NYTRIC Electrical Services will give us a quote to install additional track lighting in the sanctuary. Bob Siver will have someone look at the ceiling in the library (water damage). We will have an estimate to repair the painting "His Presence" in the narthex in the coming year.

Nurture: The movie we watched after church on January 28th was well attended. The title was "I Can Only Imagine." On January 28th the women's choir sang "Praise my Soul, the King of Heaven." A fellowship hour on February 25th will be to welcome Bob Siver and Roxanne Young, who will be installed during the worship service. On Easter Sunday (March 31) we will have a continental breakfast. Look for a sign-up sheet in friendship hall.

<u>Mission/Outreach:</u> the committee will meet in a few weeks to brainstorm about ideas for the spring and summer. *Everyone* will be invited!

Stewardship: Bob Siver gave us a brief overview of how our invested funds grew in 2023.

Rehba Clarke continues to convalesce at her daughter's home. Please keep our members and friends in your prayers, and send a card, make a call or pay a visit.


Nominating Committee: Kathie Strader will chair the committee in 2024. Members are Pat Conti and Kathie Compeau


