## Session Meeting Review Church Elders January 18, 2023

- The meeting was called to order by the moderator Reverend Sarah Lee opening with prayer. The following was discussed and decided.
- <u>Minutes</u>: The minutes of the Session Meeting for December 22, 2022, were received as corrected.
- <u>Clerks Report</u>: The Session reviewed the By-Laws of Stone Presbyterian Church. The annual meeting 2022 will be held on Feb. 5th 2023.
- **Financial:** No report. Angelo was unable to make the meeting. Financial reports will be emailed.
- Personnel: Year-end reviews of our employees will be done in January.
- **Music and Worship:** The average attendance for December was 22. Communion was celebrated on January 8, 2023. 22 people received Communion. Communion will be celebrated on February 5, 2023.
- **Building and Grounds:** Bob Siver will take care of a list of repairs that our sexton Francis pointed out. A motion was made and seconded to allow Northern Blend to use the Church on January 29, March 19, and April 23rd from 12:30 to 3:30.
- **Pastoral Care:** Esther Branche was moved from Samaritan Summit Village to the 7th floor of the Samaritan Keep Home.
- **Stewardship**: A motion was made and seconded to approve the budget for 2023 was approved for \$183,025.00. The motion passed. Bob Siver gave a report about the Invested Funds. Per Capita for 2023 is \$32.00.
- **Nurture:** Fellowship Hour will be held on January 22, 2023. February's Fellowship Hour will be held on February 5, 2023. Christian Education was discussed for our children. The board decided to advertise to hire a childcare person as well as a children's Sunday School teacher.
- **Pastor's Report:** Reverend Lee has been working on the bulletins and the newsletter. She mailed bulletins to members and friends. Planned worship services with PowerPoint screens. Reverend Sarah is encouraging the session members as well as any members or friends to read the Bible in a year. She handed out reading guides to help us accomplish our daily reading. There will be a United Presbyterian Women of Jefferson County meeting held on January 26, 2023. Helping Hands is looking into the possibility of a craft day at a senior citizen center. The items from the Mitten Manger were taken to Urban Mission.
- **Nominating Committee:** The Nominating Committee (Kathie Strader, Kathie Compeau and Pat Conti) is working on filling the seats on the Session.



Help Wanted

Children Sunday School Head Teacher (1 to 6 children Pre-K -12) and a Child Caregiver (up to 6 children-under 4 years old) for 40 minutes to 1.5 hour on Sundays

Sunday Head teacher \$20 per Hour

Sunday Child Caregiver \$ 15 per Hour

Sunday school-based curriculum (session approved) After a short children's message in Sunday worship, bring children to a

classroom or a nursery (a toy room)

When we have Communion Sunday (once a month), we invite all children to participate.

For Head Teacher: 1.5 hour for Sunday (10:30 AM-12:00PM) and 1.5-hour weekday for preparation (including greeting and sitting with them)

Monthly lesson plans (4 weeks) submit to the pastor (session) Encourage children to sing Christian songs and memorize the Bible Verses.

If needed, give a short children's message (less than 5 minutes) in worship (the pastor does most Sundays).
