Pastor's Pondering

I once had a conversation with someone who had stopped attending church. His struggle centered on a particular passage from the Bible, specifically the verse in Exodus where Moses implores Pharaoh to let the Israelites go. He was deeply troubled by the idea that God repeatedly hardened Pharaoh's heart, seemingly preventing him from releasing the Israelites until the final calamity struck. This led him to a disturbing conclusion: why would God harden someone's heart? Was God, in some way, responsible for their disbelief?

In response, I offered him an analogy. When we invite someone to church, and they consistently refuse, their heart may become more resistant each time. It's as though, with each rejection, their heart hardens a little more. The more God's grace is extended, the more some may choose to turn away from it, even to the point of cursing us, especially if they do not belong to God. The Bible describes this as God hardening their hearts—not as an act of divine cruelty, but as a reflection of their own persistent rejection of God's love.

It's important to remember that questioning can deepen our faith. Without the Holy Spirit's guidance, we cannot fully understand or accept Jesus' teachings. The answers we seek are found in Jesus Christ. I prayed fervently for my friend to return to church and to seek the truth in Jesus Christ, where true understanding and peace are found. Jesus reminds us that no one can come to Him unless drawn by God. God's grace is more boundless and powerful than we can ever fully comprehend.

Following Jesus has never been an easy path for His followers. Yet, it is our sacred duty to share the good news of Jesus, who meets us in our brokenness and transforms our lives with His love. We must continue to pray for those who have strayed and persist in inviting them to encounter Jesus, who alone offers the words of eternal life. Amen.
